Radio and Electronics Class Preparing for the Entry Level Amateur (HAM) Radio License

Training in Radio theory and FCC regulations sufficient to prepare students for passing the Technician Level Test.

The Technician class license permits voice operation on amateur radio bands in the Very High Frequency (VHF) range and on selected lower (or HF) ranges where world-wide communications are possible.

The radios used have a range much greater than unlicensed radios (so-called Family Radio). Other uses are Amateur Television, Satellite Communication, and remote control on frequencies not available to others.

The students can upgrade their license to use additional frequencies and techniques where world-wide communication is possible.

(Upgrade study groups are held as interest dictates.)
